If you would prefer to complete a hard copy form, please contact the school office and we can arrange to send one home with your child for completion by the 2nd of November.

Warragul Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

We buy our stationery packs in bulk to get discounts from our suppliers. We do not charge our families GST on our stationery packs, which gives you an additional saving. Warragul Primary School charges families at cost price and does not make a profit on sale of stationery packs. You have the option to purchase a stationery pack through the school or you can purchase it yourself and send it to school with your child on the first day in 2021. Please note if you choose to purchase your own stationery pack, there are still some items that must be purchased from the school.
